### **School Uniform**

It has come to my attention that since returning to school after the Christmas break, a number of children are wearing a selection of garments and footwear that do not comply with our School Uniform Policy.

We have a compulsory school uniform and P.E. kit, which we expect all pupils to wear. This helps pupils feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance and ensures pupils are appropriately dressed for the various learning activities throughout the school day.

Our uniform consists of –  
Navy or Black trousers, skirt or pinafore  
Navy sweatshirt or cardigan (with the school logo)  
Red polo short (school logo optional)  
Black school shoes.

### **P.E. kit**

Navy shorts, plain white round neck T-shirt with school logo and trainers for outdoor lessons (dark-coloured tracksuits may be worn in the winter months).  
It is essential that all children change for a PE lesson, it is particularly important that children change their footwear.

### **Jewellery**

Smart watches, necklaces, bracelets, and any hoop or drop earrings; are NOT permitted in school at all. However plain stud earrings are permitted, but they MUST be removed for PE lessons (pupils must tape up their earrings if they are unable to be removed).

### **Outdoor Footwear**

Our grass areas are very muddy at this time of year and children wishing to access these during playtimes will need to have a separate pair of outdoor shoes that they can change into. These could be wellies or an old pair of trainers. This helps to keep the corridors and classrooms mud free!

All items of clothing, including coats and PE kits must be named.
